### VI. PRESENTATIONS -

A. Ms. Peggy Trigg – Studio Tour

Ms. Peggy Trigg informed the Council regarding the Questa Art Studio Tour that will be showcasing the strength of our artistic traditions and developing an economic benefit for our local artists and craftspeople. The event will take place August 6 and 7, 2016. A website has already been developed and will be linked online to Questa Tourism, Enchanted Circle, NM True and NM Studio Tours. Possible funding sources include artist fees and grants from Questa Economic Development Fund board, Chevron and Taos Lodgers Tax.

Councilor Jaramillo asked Ms. Trigg if she has asked the previous members about what worked and did not work for them. Ms. Trigg stated that she has. Councilor Ortega asked that local artists be contacted and included.

B. Ms. Claire Cote – Report on LEAP 2015 Events & Update on Proposed 2016 Events

Ms. Claire Cote gave a brief report on last year's events. The Luz Es Vida series was a great success. This year's series will be geared towards Pollination. The 2016 Questa Summer Event Series and Educational Programming will begin March 26<sup>th</sup> with the local food and gardening night, banner painting and art workshops, rotating youth art exhibitions, earth day trash collection day, earth day celebration, Northern Taos county growers and makers market, Art show and Neo Rio at Wild Rivers. Ms. Cote went over the budget and stated that 13.5% of the total budget will be requested from the Questa Economic Development Board with the approval of the Village Council. Councilor Jaramillo stated that he did attend the Earth Day event and it was a great success. Also, he introduced Mr. Chino to Ms. Cote and Ms. Trigg and encouraged them to sit down and discuss these events.

Mayor Gallegos stated that they are speaking with Mr. Joey Perovich regarding leasing the property in town to hold some of these events.

VII. <u>PUBLIC COMMENTS</u> - (It is the policy of the Governing Body to accept public comment. Because your particular issue is not on the agenda the Governing Body cannot respond immediately, but may direct staff to address issues at a future Council Meeting. Public comments are limited to a maximum of three minutes.)

Mr. Phillipe Chino, Executive Director of the Questa Economic Development Fund asked if he could give a brief update on the Visitor's Center to the Council at this time.

Councilor Ortega requested that Mr. Chino be placed as a regular agenda item from now on for his updates.

Mr. Chino informed the Council that they have hired Lighthouse Creative to create a book which will be used for fundraising purposes but more importantly be used for tourism. What they did was come up with four subjects that they want us to look at in order to advertise our area. They are the background and history, agriculture, Questa present and future and mining. They came up with a draft for each section. They spoke with people in the community to come up with the final draft. A sketch of the building was also drafted. Aside from it being a visitor's center it will also be a community center. It is in the very preliminary stage. We would like to invite the lead consultant to do a complete presentation for the Council to get your approval and ideas. We would like to do this at the meeting of March 8<sup>th</sup>.

There were no other Public Comments.

#### VIII. PUBLIC HEARING -

A. Village of Questa Ordinance 2016-146 – Municipal Judge Salary Increase

Ms. Trujillo informed the Council that at the last meeting this ordinance was introduced. This ordinance must be approved prior to an election. If it approved this evening it will take effect March 1st.

Mayor Gallegos opened the Public Hearing at 6:45pm and asked if there were any comments from the public. There were no Public comments regarding the ordinance. Mayor Gallegos closed the Public Hearing at 6:46pm.

B. Request for Zoning Variance – Ms. Marsha Romero, Property at 33 Sagebrush Road

Ms. Trujillo stated that Ms. Romero came before the council in November 2014. Ms. Romero is requesting a mobile home be placed on her property which is a half acre lot. The current structures on the property cover 16% of the property. According to our zoning ordinance, this location is zoned as residential which allows for one residential unit on the property which is the reason for Ms. Romero to request the variance.

Mayor Gallegos opened the Public Hearing at 6:47pm.

Ms. Romero stated that the mobile home will be placed behind her existing home. Ms. Trujillo stated that the mobile home will require its own water meter and sewer tap. Ms. Romero stated that she is requesting this variance for the reason that her daughter needs a place of her own and she would like to help her out. Ms. Trujillo stated that it all the structures will take up to 27% of the property. Councilor Jaramillo requested that the action item state up to 47% to give them the flexibility in case they would like to add a porch or other structure and she won't have to come back again for the request. Councilor Ortega stated that he was fine with this as long as they get the required building permits. Mayor Gallegos stated that he believes that we should specify what we will be allowing such as front porch or back porch so instead of giving out a certain percentage, we know exactly what we are approving. Ms. Trujillo stated that within Taos County's permit application there is a section the Village needs to sign off on saying the improvements meet the Village of Questa zoning requirements. Councilor Ortega asked if there was any property transfer. Ms. Romero stated that there is not.

There were no other public comments. Mayor Gallegos closed the Public Hearing at 6:56pm.
