#### IX. MATTERS FROM ATTORNEY CHRIS DEFILLIPPO

Mr. DeFillippo stated that the only possible pending litigation is in regards to Mr. Lawrence Ortega's water line that currently runs diagonally through property which is not owned by the Village; we are still trying to determine if there are any easements on the water line or if the line is owned by the Village. It is his opinion that there is no obligation for the Village to move that line. It ultimately is the decision of the Governing Body.

#### X. MATTERS FROM ADMINISTRATOR, MAYOR AND COUNCIL

Mayor Gallegos asked the Council if they prefer Mr. Maestas' report in the packet for review before the meeting or presented at the meeting. It was a consensus of the Council that they be able to review it before the meeting.

Mr. Maestas stated that with all of the new snow, the public works department have been very busy plowing and salting the roads. Councilman Ortega stated that he did hear from some people in town that the public works did do a good job on the roads. He asked how their budget is looking for purchasing salt. Mr. Maestas stated that there is a good surplus of salt currently but we may have to order some more.

Mayor Gallegos reminded the Council about Municipal Day at the Legislature. It will be held on February 20<sup>th</sup>.
