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## I. <u>CALL TO ORDER BY MAYOR MARK L. GALLEGOS</u>

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Mayor Pro-Tem Louise Gallegos called the meeting to order at 6:34 pm.

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#### V. **PUBLIC HEARING**

The Village of Questa Governing Body will hold a Public Hearing in order for the public to provide input to the Village of Questa 2019/2020 annual fiscal budget.

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Mayor Pro-Tem Gallegos opened the public hearing at 6:36.

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Ms. Karen Shannon stated that she set up an interim budget balance recap report.

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- The General Operating Fund for the new budget will start with a beginning cash of \$466,326.00; Revenues at \$766,648.00, no transfers-in. The expenditures are \$951.875.00; Transfers-out to other funds are \$131,730.00. We do have a required 1/12<sup>th</sup> reserve requirement of \$39,322.00 and an ending cash of
- \$70,046.64. These numbers are a bit different than what was included in the packet for the reason that the

quote for the repair of the roof at the fire department came in much higher than anticipated. Monies from the General Fund were taken to cover this expense. Councilman Gonzales asked how much the repair will cost. Ms. Shannon stated the quote came in at \$61,942.00. Councilman Ortega asked if we found out if the \$50,000.00 we received from the legislature could be used to cover this cost. Ms. Martinez stated she would look into it.

Ms. Shannon went over the changes for each fund.

A discussion was held regarding money in the grant writer line item. Councilman Ortega asked if this money could be used to send a couple employees to a grant writing class. Mr. Christian Isely stated that he believes that the money was given from QEDF specifically for Mr. Amalio Madueno; suggested the Village go before the QEDF and clarify.

A discussion was held regarding the gas conversion at the Business Park. Councilman Ortega asked if the Village has contacted Kit Carson to see if an energy audit can be done; it might be worthwhile for them to come and look at it before we invest money into the conversion.

Mayor Pro-Tem Gallegos closed the public hearing at 7:06.

## VI. **FINANCIALS** – Ms. Karen Shannon, Finance Director

A) Discussion, Consideration & Decision - Review & Approval of Fiscal Year 2020 Interim

Budget

 Ms. Shannon stood for any questions. She stated that she has not received any changes to the budget from the Council. Councilman Ortega stated that he has a hard time approving the budget with the administrator position still built into it; for the fact that that money has been taken out and spend elsewhere. He feels that if we are approving a budget where money can be moved from one area to be spent elsewhere, there really is no point for the Council to vote on it because our approval doesn't matter. Councilman Gonzales thanked the staff and everyone who worked on the Healing Field; it was a great success.

Councilman Ortega thanked the staff, Mayor-Pro Tem Gallegos, Chevron and all volunteers.

Councilman Jaramillo stated that it went over well; he thanked the staff, volunteers and sponsors. He also asked if the staff would be going back to working regular hours since Mr. Maestas is no longer with the Village. Ms. Martinez stated that we have not gone back to that schedule and have not really considered it since it is still working for everyone and we make sure we are always here for the customers and that our work is getting done. Mayor Pro-Tem Gallegos stated that the important thing is that the work is getting done and the public is being taken care of; we are public servants. She stated that the staff knows how it is working and if it works this way she does not see any reason for it to change. Mayor Pro-Tem Gallegos also thanked

107 the staff for the work on the Healing Field as well as the day to day work. She stated that there is less criticism out in the public and work is getting done. She stated that we are going to need more volunteers and 108 organizations involved because so many of the flags need to be replaced as well as the labels. 109 110 111 Councilman Jaramillo asked who the lead person from the Village will be to assist with the library group.
