C) Discussion, Consideration & Decision – Zoning Variance Request regarding Mr. Flavio Cisneros

Ms. Coleman stated Mr. Cisneros' variance request was brought forth to council due to the status of the Zoning ordinance Mr. Cisneros' structure is not in compliance with the current Zoning ordinance as it reads. A variance approval is needed due to the zoning district identified as agricultural and the size of structure being changed from its original non - conforming structure size and use.

Councilwoman Gallegos asked 1.9 acres is that is stated on his paperwork enough property to erect the carport. Ms. Coleman stated the staff believes that property size is sufficient, however, the need for variance approval is to address the zoning area and change of non-conforming structure size.

D) Discussion, Consideration & Decision – Zoning Variance Request regarding Ms. Susie Pacheco

Ms. Coleman stated Ms. Pacheco and her siblings are requesting to place a 22x30 carport structure on their property. The family has two half acre lots and would like to place the carport structure in a manner that would take up space on both sides of the properties. A variance approval is needed due to the size of the structure and the lack of property size for use due to its non-compliance with the Zoning ordinance as it reads.

Councilor Jaramillo asked Village Attorney Mr. DeFillippo if there would be any type of set back issues since the family is wanting to place the structure on both pieces of property. Mr. DeFillippo stated that the ordinance does address setbacks in both the front and rear and the sides of the property.

A question was raised by Councilor Gonzales regarding the approval from family members of the property and if they have signed off in agreement of the structure. Ms. Coleman stated that Ms. Pacheco and her siblings were requested to provide this paperwork and signatures in agreement. The family did so with proper notarized documents.

Mr. DeFillippo had a concern with the future of the property. He believes that the carport being on two potential properties could be an issue should either party want to sell property in the future.

E) Discussion, Consideration & Decision – Zoning Variance Request regarding Michael & Cynthia Tillman

Ms. Coleman Stated that the property .233of an acre is located on Hwy 522 next to the EMS building within in the business district. The variance request is to allow temporary use of a 34-foot RV for occasional camping and a future storage unit to be built and possibly a carport. A variance approval is needed due to the lack of property size, requested use of property and its non-compliance with the Zoning ordinance as it reads.

Mayor Gallegos asked Ms. Coleman if our ordinance addresses allowable use and length of stay in an RV on a property. Ms. Coleman stated that our ordinance does not and they the Village staff has relied on the county for guidance with these issues prior. Mayor Gallegos further discussed the many issues with our ordinance and the challenges of variance approvals.

Ms. Twillman called in to explain how she purchased the property and her intentions on using the property. She also explained that she came to the Village to request utility services which was approved by Village staff because it can be provided, however, she did not know that she could not use it as she wanted, since her deeds states that there are no restrictions to the property. Mayor Gallegos addressed Ms. Twillman and further explained the requirements to the property and understands her confusion as it pertains to the use regulations.

Councilor Gonzales asked for further information such as a drawing of the pad that Ms. Twillman has mentioned putting on the property, but she stated that the pad is already there.

Mr. DeFillippo questioned the location of the property. After learning that it in the business district he stated that one of the permitted uses to the property is parking lot or parking garage and a carport can possibly qualify.

After further discussion, a decision was made.
