Christian Isely stated that Chevron is very excited about the new year and all the projects happening. He also stated that there was a recent article in the Taos News regarding a water rights sale under the Abeyta Settlement. They were not contacted by the Taos News to comment on it; it was probably out of the public notification process from the Office of the State Engineer. This transaction has been years in the making; they are selling 133acre ft. of water rights / \$16,000.00 an acre foot funded under the Abeyta settlement to some mutual domestics in the Taos area. He stated that Bill Miller is working very actively with the Village to determine what the Village's water system needs are. Also working in a conservation plan and 40-year plan. He stated that Chevron does know that the Village does need water rights and they have water rights that are looking forward to the results of Bill Millers work to determine what water rights are needed for the municipal system.
