VII. DISCUSSION ITEM

A) MOU between the Village of Questa & Taos County/Taos County Sheriff's Department for Police Services

Sheriff Jerry Hogrefe was present to answer any questions and concerns regarding the MOU between the Village and Taos County.

- Ms. Martinez added in the duties that the officers will be preforming while they are on patrol.
 - Councilor Gonzales inquired about 24-hour police coverage.

Sheriff Hogrefe addressed the question by explaining his schedule plan. He intends to stagger the hours of the officers to provide 12 hours dedicated patrol time in Questa but 24 on-call service to the Questa area.

- Councilman Gonzales was very complimentary in regard to the recent presence of the Taos County Sheriff's Department.
- Attorney Chris DeFillippo expressed some concerns as regarding the draft MOU.

It was concluded that attorneys from both, the Village and Taos county would further review the contract and look into optional changes.

- Councilman Gonzales asked if the Village can lease the Ford F150 to the County. Attorney Chris DeFillippo stated that he would look into that as an option.
- Councilman Ortega had a concern with the lack of animal control in the Village and requested that it
 be added to the MOU, was also very complimentary regarding the presence of the Sheriff's
 department.

Sheriff Hogrefe explained that for the most part animal control is a part of the agreement, however, in the past there was a concern that the Village did not have a contract with Stray Hearts Animal Shelter.

Sheriff Hogrefe wanted to address item 12, regarding use of the police building. He asked if the facility is currently insured for housing of short-term inmate for processing?

A) Review of May 2020 Financials

Ms. Shannon state, the financial report for May is available and stood for any questions.

 • Councilman Gonzales – Inquired about intergovernmental grants, on page 4. He questioned the benchmark amount versus the YTD amount, and the budget amount. Where did the difference come from?

Ms. Shannon stated, that there where grants that had not been paid and also expenditures and budgets that hadn't been budgeted. Those changes will be in bars at the next council meeting to close out the quarter.

Councilman Gonzales also inquired on the status of the Audit findings from the previous year, have they been corrected?

Mrs. Shannon stated that the audit findings from the previous year have been addressed and others are in the process of being implemented

• Councilman Ortega – Asked Ms. Martinez the status on the CDBG Business park funding.

She stated that she has been working with DFA regarding this funding and they have assured her that the Village we will be receiving the grant money in September.

Councilman Jaramillo – Stated he had no questions at this time.

 • Councilman Gonzales – Asked Ms. Martinez if we have all the money for Business park and is here a timeline for them to pay? She stated that we do not have it all in house, but we do have all the commitments from all entities. We have been invoicing and we are working on it.

Mayor Gallegos – Stated that there has been a modified adjustment made if CDBG does not come through and fulfill their end of the project participation. The Village will be seeking funding for the balance through federal funds that are available. As a precautionary measure the engineers and contractors are prepared to draw back on work, based on funding availability.

 Mr. DeFillippo stated he sent Mayor Gallegos and Council a copy of a few memorandums that were drafted, in relation to the documents that were previously discussed. The documents are the newest received from NMED and Chevron regarding the status of numerous parts of the reclamation project. 70,000 pages of documents are available for review.

Mayor Gallegos – Stated that because the documents are so lengthy, he would like to have a special meeting to review the documents prior to a meeting with federal and state agencies.

Mr. DeFillippo ,states that there are many documents to come and he will address the newest and historical docs as per requested.
