#### X.) DISCUSSION ITEM

A) Temporary RV Spaces

Mayor shared with the Council the need to create an agreement, ordinance, special permit or something that will support temporary and / or short-term RV stays. There has been an increase in requests from residents to the Village asking for allowance of RV's to be placed on their land for short term RV rental. This has come about due to the new Rock Pile Reclamation project that has brought in traveling workers to the Ouesta area.

The Mayor and Council discussed the ideas and options to look into to support the need. Mr. DeFillippo also provided some information on the ways to structure the ideas and how the drafting of the special use permit would be possible.

### XI. MATTERS FROM ATTORNEY – Mr. Chris DeFillippo, Robles, Rael & Anaya

Mr. DeFillippo gave updates to the following matters:

- Update and invite to the quarterly meeting between EPA, Chevron and the Village of Questa to be held Thursday June 10, 2021. There was much conversation regarding all the issues that need to be addressed at the meeting such as the ongoing contaminated soils on Embargo, plumb studies, tailings, health studies, the ditch association and having a complete clean up.
- Recommendation for the Village to create a Planning and Zoning Board. This board will assist in zoning and variance requests that come in. They will review all requests and make recommendations to Mayor and Council as they support the Zoning Ordinance.
- Llano Ditch Association request for payment. Mr. DeFillippo is still waiting for documentation stating that the Village owns the property being invoiced.
- Cell tower update, there should be a team to come out and provide 4G soon.

# XII. MATTERS FROM ADMINISTRATION- Ms. Renee Martinez, CMC /Interim Administrator

Ms. Martinez gave updates to the following matters.

- The 17<sup>th</sup> Annual Veterans Healing Field of Honor was a success due to the help of Entact and Councilwoman Gallegos for assisting with getting the ball rolling.
- The Library Grand Opening is scheduled for Sat. June 12, 2021 at 1pm.
- There are 3 new employees coming on board in the next week, Receptionist, Public Works Laborer, Library Assistant
- Public Works Department did receive the vehicles from the EMS Department.

Councilwoman Gallegos was very appreciative of the porta potties.

Councilman Ortega received positive feedback about the Healing Field from some folks out of Angel Fire. He also asked if the Village has gone out to bid on the Cabresto Paving Project yet and how long once it has been out to bid will we see actual work happening. Ms. Martinez stated that the Village would advertise for bids for at least 21 days and follow the process of procurement and that could take several weeks to complete.

#### XIII. MAYOR AND COUNCILMEMBERS

#### A) Concerns and/or Announcements

• Mayor brought a request forward on behalf of the Village Public Works Department. The Public Works would like the Council to consider using any carryover funding that may be available from the project to replace PRV Vault. This will allow for a more sufficient and functioning system. Councilor Jaramillo asked if CDBG was okay with making the change to the scope? Ms. Martinez and Mayor Gallegos assured him that they had spoken to Mr. Lacy at the CDBG office and felt confident that the request would be approved by Mr. Lacy and his department. Councilman Gonzales asked if the current contractor was doing this work, Mayor Gallegos stated that the Contractor is not as he is working on his current contract scope of work.

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• Mayor gave an update on meeting that he had with Mr. David Kisten with Sandia Labs, LANL and Workforce Solutions. They have interest in the business park to assist in getting businesses into the business park. Councilman Gonzales asked if the prior engineers were responsible with doing the work on the vault.

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### B) New Business to be considered at future Council Meetings.

There was ongoing conversation regarding the upcoming meeting that the attorney referenced above. The Council was encouraged to email Mr. DeFillipo their questions and concerns to be shared during the June 10, 2021 EPA, Chevron and Village meeting.
