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Mr. Christian Isely, Chevron Representative (Caller 01) Gave an update to the Granite rock pile reclamation project forward next week we will start to see the hauling in of aggregate material coming into the project starting June 2nd, there will be trucks coming into town from the north generally this will vary between 10-14 trucks per day carrying approximately 6 loads. He stated that this phase of the project will continue until September.

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B) Discussion, Consideration & Decision Resolution No. 2021-12 / A Resolution regarding purchase of property on North Kiowa Road

Mayor Gallegos presented an offer of \$100.00 that was made by Mr. and Mrs. Jake Montoya to purchase a 7-foot strip of property located near 99 North Kiowa. The property is of no use to the Village and would be more costly to have it appraised. Per questions and slight concern from Council, Mr. DeFillippo stated that this dollar amount does not set a precedence, but simply accepting the \$100.00 offer.

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153 154 Councilman Ortega asked Mr. DeFillippo if the Village accepts the offer of \$100.00 made by the Montoya's does this become the fair market value of any other property in area in the future? Mr. DeFillippo stated that he does not believe so. His understanding of how appraisal works is that you take like properties from around the area and then you come with some sort of determination of what the property value would be, should another section be appraised he assumes that they would use the same structure to determine that price perhaps taking into account that the Village did sell this specific piece of property for that amounts but he does not think that it sets any precedent or standard for future sales.

155 Councilman Ortega also asked why it had taken so long to address the request of Mr. and Ms. Montoya? 156 Mayor Gallegos explained and stated that in the future it is the Village's intent to address in a timely manner. 157

A request of \$150,000.00 rather than the \$120,000.00 has already been sent and a pending County meeting 239

240 will be set to review and discuss this request. Mayor explained the need for more funding as well as reaching out to Chevron for added assistance to the Questa /EMS Department. Councilman Ortega also suggested that more wildland gear is needed too.

Councilman Ortega also shared that Vida del Norte will be starting Thursday Night Movies and would like to have sponsors provide popcorn and drinks. He said that they are also beginning to plan upcoming events.

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Councilman Gonzales stated that RTD will have a new building in Taos County.

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Councilman Jaramillo appreciated the Public Works and staff for the successful dumpster / clean up day. He suggests that we plan for a fall dumpster / cleanup day.
