X.) DISCUSSION ITEM

A) Village of Questa Procurement Policy

Ms. Coleman provided the Mayor and Council with recommendations and requests for some changes to the procurement policy that would assist in streamlining and simplifying the process. This comes after working with a procurement consultant that thoroughly reviewed the policy and came up with some new threshold amounts. There was much discussion about the proposed requests, and it was recommended by Mayor and Council to make some more changes and bring before the Council for the next meeting.

 B) Establishment of a Planning & Zoning Board

Mr. DeFillippo presented his recommendation of a 5-member Planning and Zoning Board that would enforce the Planning and Zoning Ordinance. He explained that the board could be created and what the boards authority would be. The Council will continue to review and make some decisions and they will plan a work study session to the Planning and Zoning Ordinance and board selection.

C) RV Short Term Rentals

Continued conversations regarding the Planning and Zoning Map and Ordinance as it pertains to short term RV rental spaces. Mr. DeFillippo shared his concerns and the lack of support for these types of request. Right now, there is no language to approve or variance a request for a short-term rental. There was much conversation about this topic but no decision and final direction on how to move forward would be recommended until the proposed Planning and Zoning Ordinance is finalized.

XI. MATTERS FROM ATTORNEY – Mr. Chris DeFillippo, Robles, Rael & Anaya

Mr. DeFillippo gave updates to the following matters:
