 - 2. Lodger's Tax Assessment /Ordinance: Research and draft Lodger's Tax Business Plan with community input to guide a proposal for a Village Ordinance
 - 3. Outdoor Recreation Development: Using the Questa Recreation Assessment Report, garner community input to prioritize recreation projects for development; seek grant funding
 - 4. Water Rights Transfer Policy Change/Agricultural:
 - Advocate legislators to change water rights transfer policies so new agricultural opportunities and an agricultural co-op can be established
