128 D) Discussion, Consideration, & Decision, Change Order for Cabresto Road Pavement, Mrs.
Karen Quintana Shannon presented to the Council a change order that was presented to the
Village for the pavement of Cabresto Road. She did ask that a decision not be made at this time
due to the last-minute documentation obtained and provided and needs to be revised. Dave Falc
from NV5 provided a change order with an amount that was over budget, Mrs. Quintana
Shannon will be getting a revised change order to collate with the amount of budget allowed.
The total project budget is 1.5 million and 1.1 million has already been spent. There is an
allocation of money in the amount of \$115,000.00 that is set to expire at the end of the year,
which is the reason the Village is trying to find a way to spend the funding before expiration.
Mrs. Quintana Shannon will be in contact with NV5 to get a revised change order to reflect an
amount that will not go over budget for the project. A special meeting will be scheduled before
the next regular Council Meeting. No action was taken on the discussion per Mayor and Council

 Councilman Jason Gonzalez presented the idea of bringing Pickle Ball and Frisby Golf perhaps at the Molycorp Field. Mayor Ortega suggested the 23 acres that was donated to the Village of Questa off Don Martinez Road for the use of outdoor recreation. Mayor Ortega reminded the Council of the retreat scheduled for October 22 in partnership with QEDF. Mayor Ortega stated the Village of Questa 40-year water plan has been approved and the over diversion of water is also being worked on. October 25 is a regular Council Meeting and October 27 is a special meeting for some zoning variances. Tentative public hearing for the raise of water rates scheduled for the first week of November. NFL Flag football is scheduled for their first clinic October 15, 2022, at the Questa High School. The Village of Questa public work staff will do their best ensure that the pothole problem be worked on. Village of Questa Audit moved from October 11 to November 28th. Mayor Ortega also presented the purchase of 3 police units at a discounted rate completely outfitted for \$5,000.00 each vehicle. Village of Questa Trunk o Treat is scheduled for October 28, 2022. Councilwoman Gallegos inquired about the Administrator position and asked if anyone has applied, at this time only one application has been obtained.
