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#### X. DISCUSSION ITEM

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A) Village of Questa GRT; Mrs. Karen Quintana Shannon presented to the Council to increase the GRT. The Village of Questa current GRT Tax is 1.5626% and the allotted GRT Tax rate is at 2.5% which allows .9375% to increased within the Village of Questa. Mrs. Karen Quintana Shannon shared a presentation with the Village Council. Mrs. Karen Quintana Shannon proposed that the additional GRT tax be issued for Public Safety including Fire, EMS, and Police. The Mayor and Council agreed. They would like to take this to action as soon as possible. An election is not needed for the amount of tax increase that the Village is proposing.

- B) Village of Questa Lodgers Tax; Mrs. Karen Quintana Shannon presented and shared a presentation on
   Lodgers Tax to the Council and the benefits that it would bring to the Village of Questa. Lodgers tax can
- be used for Police, Fire Protection, Sanitation, Tourist Sanitation Facility, and events. It does not pay for
- Police Salaries, but it does cover their salaries if they cover an event. A commission with 5 board members needs to be put together, an ordinance, and a public hearing. Councilwoman Gallegos stated she would like
- the Planning and Zoning Board to be finished before the Lodgers Tax. Discussion will continue.
- 152 C) Daycare; Inspire Daycare from Taos has received a grant to help with a facility in Questa. They will be
- using the mobile units that the Village of Questa acquired from the Red River Charter school. The Council

discussed proposed locations and one of them being next to the Library. The Council and Mayor would like to take this to action on the next meeting agenda.

### XI. MATTERS FROM THE VILLAGE ATTORNEY

Chris DeFillippo stated they had their quarterly meeting with Chevron and updated the Council. Councilor Gonzalez asked a question about property within the Village of Questa and Chris DeFillippo was able to answer his question.

## XII. MATTERS FROM THE ADMINISTRATOR

- Mrs. Karen Quintana Shannon presented the Village Easter Egg hunt was a success and everyone was very happy and excited.
- Living Word Ministries Men's Group volunteered their time and were able to color code all of the flags for organization and preparation for the Annual Healing Field Ceremony
- The phone line at EMS is currently not working. Mrs. Karen Quintana Shannon has reached out to Century Link to switch over to them to ensure that all our communication lines are working.
- The budget workshop is scheduled for April 22, 2023, from 9-4 at the Village Chambers.
- The Village of Questa has been looking in changing the liability and employee benefit insurance. Upon further review, the decision at this time is the NM Municipal League as well as the State Insurance
- There was a minor fire near the Village of Questa Park property. There was an issue with a locked gate. Mrs. Karen Quintana Shannon presented to the Council the learning experiences and changes that the staff will be implementing to ensure that any and all emergencies are handled accordingly, and all communication is upfront immediately. A fire ordinance will be in the works to ensure that safety and accountability will be held.

# XIII. MATTERS FROM THE MAYOR AND COUNCILMEMBERS

• Councilor Jaramillo expressed gratitude to Valerie Vigil for the Easter Egg Hunt and Councilor Gonzalez for his clean up.

 • Councilwoman Katrina Gonzales stated she attended the Fiesta Planning Committee. At this time, it is unclear if it will move forward. The proposed date is June 10, 2023. There is also a Fish Fiesta and a Car Show on the same day.

 Councilor Gonzalez will have his last Friday clean up day on April 14, 2023. The Clean up days will then move to Saturdays; Dates are pending.
Councilor Gonzalez requested information on the Corrals for possible leasing. Further information

needs to be obtained.

Councilor Gonzalez would like to ensure that the Village of Questa Properties are being rented out at market value to ensure that everyone is getting charged relatively the same.

• Councilor Gonzalez spoke on the NPRTPO projects. 11 projects were submitted and 7 of those were from Questa. The projects need to be condensed to top 3 and presented again in May for a decision at the NPRTPO meeting.

• There will be a Community Clean up Day April 20 with the Honor Society.

 • Councilor Gallegos inquired about the MVD Position opening. She asked that a letter be sent to any recipients that do not get the job.

 Mayor Ortega stated our Officers are busy and out on the streets. Many compliments are being made towards our new Police Officers.

Mayor Ortega and Mrs. Karen Quintana Shannon met with the Taos Soil and Water Conservation. They are looking for a fiscal agent and would like to partner with the Village of Questa.
